The MDSDS trophy will be awarded to the best young handler under the age of 16.  
The Bill Brown Perpetual Memorial Trophy will be awarded to the best young handler under the age of 21. N.B. It is the competitors responsibility to return their trophy a month before the trials, failure to do so will result in their entry not being accepted.

### RULES

Competitors will be judged on their handling ability **ONLY**.

The competition is restricted to **ONE RUN** per dog. **Dogs can only be run once.**

Any standard of dog may be run. However the dog **WILL NOT** be judged and **WILL NOT** receive any points

Under 16 Young Handlers may run a dog in the Young Handlers Class which has already been entered in the Local Classes, (excluding the Young Handlers), by the bona fide owner.

The classes will be run in accordance with the current rules of the Macclesfield Sheep Dog Trials Association.

All entrants must be 'local' - residing within a twenty-five-mile radius of Macclesfield Town Hall or a son/daughter of a committee member.
